

Wish List for ENHT as at 7th April, 2020

Items can be purchased or donated – the underlying need is because we are finding it difficult to procure these items nationally in the current crisis – ideally, they could be sourced or made locally.

1. Theatre Scrubs – for staff to wear instead of uniform – need to be checked by infection control. Drawstring bags to put scrubs in for laundering.
2. Visors for personal protection – need to be checked by PPE team
3. Digital radios for staff and wards – preferably battery powered
4. Baby monitors (Vtech 111) – again, battery powered
5. Nespresso coffee machines with pods
6. Items to entertain isolated patients – adult and children eg activity books, puzzles
7. Toiletries and towels for staff unable to go home – pref in individual bags
8. Groceries for staff pop up shop eg milk, eggs, bread, coffee etc
9. Frozen ready meals for staff and covid wards
10. Packaged snacks for staff well being area – sandwiches, fruit, crisps, chocolate, juices
11. Individual hand gels, antibacterial wipes, hand creams, face moisturiser in bags for staff

Other items on our staff wish list may require us to buy and install them ourselves so any dedicated funding would be gratefully received. For example the following items need funding –

1. Refurbishment and decoration of our coffee lounge into a staff support and well being area.
2. Furniture and other equipment for the staff well being area.
3. Creation and set up of rest/sleep areas for staff across wards incl bed/sleeper chairs.
4. iPads for isolated patients to communicate with their families (need to be purchased and set up by our IT team.
5. Advanced medical equipment/technology to enhance care of covid patients.
