The Queen's Commonwealth Trust (QCT) was launched on April 21st 2018 in recognition of Her Majesty The Queen's lifetime of service to others and her love for the Commonwealth and its young people. With Her Majesty's blessing, the Diamond and Silver Jubilees focused on young people helping others. The Lord Lieutenants played an active role, alongside local communities, in celebrating and supporting the work of amazing young leaders in the UK and around the globe. QCT carries this legacy forward.

Around the world, we are facing urgent challenges. Covid-19 has shown us that we depend on each other and we need to work differently, together, to make the world a better place. To bring about positive change, it is vital that funding and support goes to the right place.

For the Platinum Jubilee, QCT is open for donations to support young people who are driving transformational results in their communities – in education, healthcare, employment, the environment and more. Less than 0.1% of international aid goes to leaders like them, the ones most affected by the challenges and with solutions that work. Their collective potential is enormous. We want to unlock it.

QCT provides three key elements founders tell us they need to succeed:

Flexible Funding

Because young entrepreneurs know their work best and where investment is needed.

Practical Tools

to help strengthen their organisations and build strong and resilient systems of financial management, governance and impact tracking.

A Global Network

of like-minded young entrepreneurs, providing an ecosystem of advice, support and encouragement. This is the QCT Network Hub.

We will demonstrate the difference these ventures make to the communities where they operate. We want to build a movement of supporters, who together will help drive more investment to the interventions that work. There is no time to lose. Together, we can secure the future we all want to see.

Flexible Funding

QCT provides flexible grants and works with young people for at least two years. It selects organisations working across the UN Sustainable Development Goals that are at a tipping point, where support at the right time can make a big difference.

Flexible funding for maximum impact

Flexible (unrestricted) funding is rare but highly valuable as it allows founders to choose to invest where it will have the best effect. We work closely with founders to monitor performance regularly and focus on impact and results.

Young people at the heart of our grant-making

QCT's grant-making strategy is developed with young people who know and understand the pressures young founders face. They help with grants assessments and monitoring and ensure we focus on the criteria that matter most for impact. They continue to play a growing part in our work.



Our Global Network

The work that founders undertake is challenging and complex. Making change is hard and leadership can be lonely. We provide access to a mission-aligned global network that helps founders support each other and access insights and resources to further their work and impact.

Our network comprises over 850 people around the world who are driving positive change.

The QCT Network Hub is where they come together to learn, share ideas and collaborate. Every UN SDG is represented, with members in each of the 54 Commonwealth countries, including from Indigenous communities and marginalised groups.

Impact in Action with Eco Brixs: Creating value from plastic waste

QCT has worked with Eco Brixs since 2018, providing funding and support at a pivotal moment for the organisation as it was poised and ready for growth.

CONTEXT

Plastic pollution and unemployment are major dual issues in Uganda. Over 90% of plastic waste is sent to landfill or burnt illegally, and 83% of 15 to 24-yearolds are unemployed.

SOLUTION

Eco Brixs is a social enterprise with a business model that transforms plastic waste into marketable products and creates jobs for the local community.

IMPACT

Income opportunities created for 3,000+ people to date and 350+ tons of plastic repurposed into eco-friendly building materials, face shields for front line workers and other eco-products.

HOW QCT SUPPORT HAS DRIVEN GROWTH AND INVESTMENT FOR ECO BRIXS

Unrestricted funding from QCT enabled Eco Brixs to rapidly expand their operations by:

✓ Purchasing a collection truck \checkmark Hiring 6 new staff members ✓ Investing into their first full machine line

This allowed them to efficiently scale up their recycling system, open 3 new collection sites and fast-track taking new products to market, getting them closer to becoming financially sustainable through sales. Working with QCT has helped Eco Brixs earn the attention and support of other funders nationally and internationally, including from organisations like Tear Fund.

QCT was the first major funder to believe in our vision and has been more than essential to how we have grown to the size we are now. You've always trusted our judgement, been supportive and understand the challenges and difficulties of growing a small grassroots organisation, particularly the importance of unrestricted funding."
