### Competition details:

1. The competition is open to all Hertfordshire Key Stage 2 pupils. Maximum 10 entries to be submitted per school.
2. Entries should portray favourite memory of a Platinum Jubilee event attended or seen by the young person and should not be an illustration of Her Majesty the Queen.
3. Entries should be no larger than A3 size on paper or card. Please do not use glitter. Entries may be in pencil, paint or crayon.
4. Each entry should be marked on the back with:
  - Name and age of pupil and school year
  - Name of school and full contact details
5. Unfortunately entries cannot be returned.
6. By entering the competition, entrants are accepting that the artwork may be published and otherwise used.

### Winning entries:

1. The competition will be judged by a panel including members of the Hertfordshire Lieutenancy.
2. There will be two overall winners of the competition who will receive a Platinum Jubilee prize and certificate.
3. Hertfordshire County Council will notify schools with the winning pupils and the Lieutenancy Office will contact those schools to arrange a presentation Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> or Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July.
4. Photos of winning entries will be featured on the Lieutenancy website and on Hertfordshire County Council social media. A selection of other entries may also be featured.
5. Permission will be sought to use photos of the winning artists on the web and in press releases.
